

Dear Kappa Psi Brothers,

Kappa Psi Needs You!

I can't put it any simpler than that. At this time in Kappa Psi's history, we are in more need than ever for your support and your loyalty to Kappa Psi.

This is a new era for Kappa Psi. We have a new leadership that is dedicated to making our great Fraternity, Bigger, Stronger, and Better than the way we found it. These next two years are going to be dedicated to improving the image of Kappa Psi, and returning us to the Professional Image that we enjoyed for decades.

I know that you may have become distant from your Kappa Psi brothers. Our family, work, and personal lives all beg for our time and our resources. But if you have ever said that you would be willing to get more engaged with Kappa Psi, then now is the time!

If you have not had the opportunity to add your name to the Kappa Psi Listserve, then you may not be aware of some of the major changes that have already occurred. Here are just a few of them:

- A call for committee volunteers resulted in over 200 brothers volunteering, and all of them have been appointed to a committee
- The committee appointments have been made, and every Province is represented on almost every committee; plus every Province has at least two brothers who are chair or co-chairs.
- Two new committees were added to help strengthen Kappa Psi. The GCC Family Activities Planning Committee has been added to make sure a high priority is given to making sure our GCC's are family oriented. And the Fraternity Unity Committee has been formed to help find solutions to some of the rifts and political wrangling that is plaguing our Fraternity
- I have assigned each Executive Committee member to be a liaison to one or more committees, so the committees can have a direct link to the Executive Committee and the EC brother can regularly communicate with the committee chairs to keep the committee moving towards accomplishing their charges.
- Each Province has at least one person who is a Province Supervisor or Assistant Supervisor

I hope you agree that all of these changes show my commitment to make sure that Kappa Psi is not only for Life, but is for everyone. I am committed to showing that even if your friend or someone from your Province doesn't get elected to the Executive Committee, that doesn't mean your Province will be left out in the cold.

We have been able to make these improvements to Kappa Psi without any additional funding needed. However, to really have a chance at making Kappa Psi Bigger, Stronger, and Better, Kappa Psi is in need of your monetary support. As you know, the amount of industry funding that is available is severely limited, and therefore we need to request support from our members.

Here is a list of things that we do need monetary support for, in order to accomplish:

- **Creating and providing support for a yearly “Weekend Leadership Conference.”** This conference would allow the Regents from each chapter get over 14 hours of leadership training, that they can use to become better leaders for their Chapter, Province, and the pharmacy profession. Although the regents would be responsible for transportation costs, the hotel, the training, and some meals would be paid for by Kappa Psi. As you can imagine, although this would be an expensive endeavor, the return on investment for Kappa Psi would be immense.
- **Travel to new schools of pharmacy for the purpose of establishing new collegiate chapters.** With the continually increasing number of new schools being formed, Kappa Psi is behind the curve in establishing new chapters. All of these schools need to hear about Kappa Psi, and the students given the opportunity to become a brother. But this goal cannot be effectively completed on our current budget.
- **Expand our International Presence.** Although we are an International Fraternity, our international chapters are only in Canada. And there is an increasing International interest in Pharmacy Fraternities due to the student exchange programs that take place at various pharmacy schools in the U.S. and abroad. Due to the lack of pharmacy fraternities in foreign countries, this is an untapped market that needs to be explored.
- **Increased funding to improve the quality of our Grand Council Convention and Kappa Psi receptions during the ASHP Midyear and APhA Annual meeting.** Due to a lack of industry sponsorships, the quality of our meetings and receptions has continued to decrease over the years. We are not talking about having sterling silver plates or T-bone steaks, but these events represent part of the public face of Kappa Psi and deserve more funding that we just don't have.
- **Begin to put small Kappa Psi Ads in Pharmacy Today, and other pharmacy journals to help increase the visibility and promotion of Kappa Psi.** Even if we just put ads in the Journals to promote the Grand Council Convention and our receptions at APhA and ASHP, this would go a long way toward increasing the visibility of Kappa Psi and making us a Bigger, Stronger and Better Fraternity.

I hope that you will agree with me that Kappa Psi needs your support, and will join the Executive Committee and me in paying our voluntary dues this year. You will find on the next page, a list of the voluntary dues levels and Kappa Psi's expressions of appreciation for your support. You will also find included a list of Silver, Gold and Platinum Level brothers from last year's dues request.

If you can join me and other brothers by pledging at the Platinum Level, that would be fantastic! And I hate to use the National Public Radio ploy, but at \$500 that is less than the cost of a cup of coffee per day (\$1.37). However, a pledge at any level would be much appreciated!
